As a class, we will be creating an online memoir gallery.

Steps:

- 1. Bring in a button which will represent one person who died in the Holocaust.
- 2. Write a memoir of the person the button represents. This could be a real person's story or historical fiction in 750 words or less. The story should be only a portion of this person's life (since it's a memoir) and must directly address some aspect of the historical events Holocaust that we've studied.
- 3. Take a picture of the button to post both the picture and the story on the Peoria Holocaust Memorial's Button Memoir Project webpage.
